If you would like to apply for a grant, please use the attached form and keep in mind the following guidelines:

- Grant Requests may be submitted to any member of the Keys Foundation Board.
- Grant Requests must be submitted no later than February 15, 2008.
- All Grant Requests must have a sponsoring Rotarian who is a member in good standing of the Rotary Club of Sarasota Keys.
- The Keys Foundation has historically favored grants that are youth-oriented and education-oriented. However, that does not exclude other organizations from consideration.
- Special consideration may be given to grants that would actively involve our club members, or that would at least provide an interesting report back to our club.
- Not all grants will be accepted, and some grants might be partially funded
