In addition to his B.S. degree from Purdue, he has a Masters Degree in Management from Webster University. He has been awarded 2 meritorious Service Medals, the air medal and the Distinguished Presidential Unit citation, the National Defense Service medal and the list goes on and on and on . . .

Lee is an incredible person. We are indeed fortunate to have him as a member of the Sarasota Keys Rotary club. He is without a doubt a worker's worker. Not only does he know how to get a job done.
