Roscoe and Jan Turner sold their business in 2000 and moved to Venice, Florida. They have been enjoying their retirement by making trips to rural Thailand to help the school children there. Since November 2003, when they first met the Thai school children and decided to help, they have made 12 trips, completed 43 projects, carried 74 suitcases of donated school supplies and books, 3 kits of medical supplies (worth \$26,000 each), AND 850 hand knit sweaters. They have spent over \$125,000 for building material and associated costs for construction of schools

and orphanages: most from donations and the rest from their own pockets.

Fifty volunteers from the US, Australia, Canada, Hong Kong and Thailand have paid their own expenses and joined the Turners to help in their work in Thailand.

Roscoe is a member of the Sarasota Florida Rotary Club and

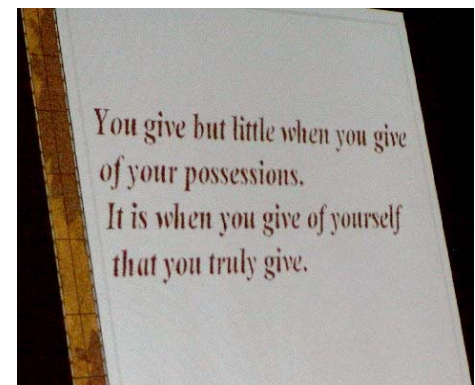
