Gale was a patron of Greater Sarasota's Great Kids Nursery and Pre-School for underprivileged children, as well as an active supporter and patron of the Williamsburg Foundation and the Heritage Foundation. She was also the co-founder of the *MacCabe Family Foundation*.

Mrs. McCabe was

an avid reader, and an excellent bridge player. She was a well-known collector of art, particularly oil paintings, and loved to entertain family and friends at her home.

Mrs. McCabe was a lifelong conservative Republican, a teacher and an administrator at Carson Valley Nursery School in *Flou r t o w n , P a . .* Of all the things that she has done, her real love was her family.
